My name is Geordie Maguire, I am a medical student in the Queen's Medicine Class of 2025. In the summer of 2022, I was diagnosed with a malignant brain tumour. This life-changing diagnosis led to a week in hospital, months of treatment and a new perspective on the patient experience. Being a patient is challenging, but there organizations making tremendous efforts to improve it. The Canadian Cancer Society (CCS) is an organization focused on providing information and support to patients, while contributing to brain cancer research. The research aims to find novel therapies to treat, cure, and improve the quality of life for patients like myself.

I have a lot to thank the CCS for, they've enabled me to read deeply personal patient stories, provided a meeting place for fellow brain tumour survivors, and allowed me to learn about my tumour at my own pace. This has given me a renewed sense of hope that I had lost after receiving my diagnosis. I am hopeful when I read about fellow survivors living incredible and meaningful lives.

I am hopeful when I see studentship research opportunities that could lead to a classmate discovering a lifesaving therapy. I am hopeful when I see organizations that continue to support patients, families and caregivers from the day of diagnosis to well beyond. This year, I wanted to contribute to the CCS through this fundraiser, to ensure these resources are available for all those affected by this disease.

Hockey has always been a great passion of mine; I played over 100 games in the Western Hockey League, and represented Queen's Golden Gaels for two seasons. In a collaborative effort with my classmates we have decided to contribute to the CCS by planning a charity hockey game. I hope through our event we are to raise awareness for this devastating diagnosis and generate donations for an important organization, while playing a sport I love with the QMed Community.
